1. Keep me safe...

- The use of *fear* as a means of gaining political control
 - 1. The French Revolution: Committee of Public Safety (1793-4)
 - 2. Society-wide compliance measures
 - 3. 'Never let a crisis go to waste.'
- Christians need to resist the temptation to live in fear
 - 1. Care for the sick, the vulnerable, the dying
 - 2. Live each day in the freedom and grace of Christ



'Obey us and you'll be safe.'


2. Show me the money...

- A spirit of entitlement is enslaving future generations to poverty
 - 1. Government handouts, grants and subsidies
 - 2. **Debt diplomacy** fuels political corruption and personal poverty
 - 3. 'The leech has two daughters: Give and give!" (Proverbs 30:15a)
- Christians need to resist the temptation to take what is not ours
 - 1. Lead by example, so we are blameless in the eyes of the community
 - 2. Schools, services, and churches need to be free of government assistance
 - 3. **Prepare** for harder times ahead



3. Trust me, I'm an expert...

- The short-circuiting of debate
 - 1. 'I <u>am</u> the science.' (Dr Fauci)
 - 2. Rule by edict, rather than representative government
 - 3. 'Fact Checker' powers to suppress all other voices
- Christian leaders need to lead by example
 - 1. Maintain openness, but with wisdom
 - 2. Encourage free speech and the sharing of ideas









Developing Issues...

4. You *can't* say that...

- Paul Fletcher MP will introduce legislation that will give Australia's media watchdog, the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA) more regulatory power over tech companies who fail to meet the standards of a voluntary misinformation and disinformation code of practice. (March 2022)
 - 1. Companies such as Facebook, Google, Apple and YouTube are required to take action to regulate content.
 - 2. Adobe has signed up and committed to regulate, monitor, and trace authorship and content—See also, the Content Authenticity Initiative (CAI).
 - 3. Third-party 'fact checkers' will provide oversight of material that citizens try to access or distribute: Misinformation and Disinformation Action Group (MADAG)
 - 4. 'Conspiracy-driven communities' will not able to be heard.



5. You must say this...

- The pressure to submit, conform, and affirm the lie is increasing:
 - 1. Same-sex marriage
 - 2. Gender fluidity, Gender pronouns
 - 3. BLM bend the knee
 - 4. Welcome to Country protocols
 - 5. Diversity Council of Australia
 - 6. Government-Corporate Alliances



 The challenge for all concerned citizens, including Christians, is to engage in the culture war on the side of truth, reality, and common sense as we see it.

6. School Curriculum Content

- Ideological categories are embedded into every subject area by the cross-curriculum priorities matrix.
 - 1. the contempt for Western Civilisation;
 - 2. the removal of almost all positive references to Christianity; and
 - 3. The promotion of social activism e.g., in Maths, students are asked to 'compare areas of Aboriginal people's traditional grain belt with Australia's current grain belt.' This assumes that the Aboriginal people were living in permanent settlements and growing crops around their villages, for which there is no historical evidence whatsoever. (Based on the discredited Bruce Pascoe's *Dark Emu* narrative.)
- Some curriculum goals usurp the rights of parents on controversial matters:
 - 1. Gender theory, human sexuality, transgender rights, social justice projects, etc.
 - 2. State-sponsored grooming of children.




